Alt #3B – Non-Functionalized Fixed Charge

Member agencies pay an annual fixed charge based on allocated Demand Management costs

- <u>Considerations</u>
 - > Functionalization of DM costs is not necessary
 - All member agencies would be subject to the DM Fixed Charge
 - Demand Management costs are largely fixed in nature and this approach provides a fixed revenue source

Hypothetical Example

<u>Member Agency A:</u> has 5% of the selected metric, e.g., population, acreage, assessed valuation, etc.

Member Agency A – Total Demand Management Annual Fixed Charge:

 $5\% \text{ of } \$100M = \frac{\$5.0M}{100M}$
